To help visitors get more out of their time in Tokyo, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government offers guided tours by Tokyo sightseeing volunteers. The tours are mainly on foot and cover themes as diverse as the hip Harajuku district, garden strolls and tea ceremony and Tokyo's political and financial districts. There are 10 tours to choose from with prices ranging from free to a maximum of 3,540 yen (£23/€26) for a private tour. Group sizes are limited to 5 people and each group is escorted by two volunteer guides.



The tours depart from the Tokyo Tourist Information Centre Head Office at the Tokyo Metropolitan Government Buildings in Shinjuku and are available in English, Chinese, Korean, German, French, Italian and Spanish. To find out more visit www.tourism.metro.tokyo.jp
